## What Is NYTD?

NYTD stands for the National Youth in Transition Database. This federal project requires all states to collect information on services paid for or provided to youth in foster care. States are also required to collect outcome information from youth transitioning out of foster care through the NYTD Survey. Taking part in the survey ensures we don't lose money for programs and services for our youth.

## How Can I Help?

- Encourage youth to take the NYTD survey and sign up for our listserv before leaving care.
